Various fishing nets (trammel, gillnets, trawl nets and more)

Fishing gear are among the priorities for sustainable solutions as ALDFG in the marine environment cause long-lasting impact. Prototypes of fishing nets have been developed by SeaBird and tested in different real-life environments for several years with promising results.

Fish crates

With the SEA®113 compound specifically adapted to injection moulding of products fish crates are the perfect example of a robust application.

Oyster mesh bags

Biodegradable oyster bags are essential in reducing marine pollution. By adopting these eco-friendly alternatives, oyster farmers can demonstrate their commitment to sustainable practices and environmental stewardship.

Oyster spat collection cups

The biodegradable oyster spat collection cups have shown to give excellent results with the incorporation of oyster shell in the biobased and biodegradable compound, also a great way to valorise local by-products.

Mussel nets

Often an essential tool for mussel farming, mussel nets are easily subject to loss in the marine environment due to possible severe weather conditions such as storms. Biobased and biodegradable alternatives are therefore of great interest.

Packaging

The applications of SeaBird compounds are not limited to the marine environment, they find outlets in other sectors such as soft or rigid packaging for the food sector.
